The state then filed a Motion to Reconsider (In layman's terms a motion asking the court to realize they did a dumb thing in the first place). Well today, the court entered an order Denying the Motion to Reconsider and not only that, if you will read the attached Order, you will see that the court called their hand by stating in the order: "There is no reason to further delay this case."
